



**A policy of the
Muskegon Railroad Historical Society
Regulating
Nominations for Election**

Enacted this September 19, 2006, the MRHS Board of Directors enact the following policy regulating nominations for elections.

Nominations for the MRHS Board of Directors and the nominating process must adhere to the conditions and requirements following.

1. The Board of Directors shall appoint a nomination committee at least two (2) months prior to the annual election.
2. In the event of a mid year election to fill a vacancy, the Board of Directors will accept and collect nominations.
3. The nomination committee shall be composed of at least five (5) active members in good standing, with at least two (2) of those members being members of the Board of Directors.
4. Nomination may be either written or verbal
5. Nominations may be either from the nominee themselves or from an active member in the MRHS
6. Acceptance of the nomination must be acknowledged by the member nominated.
7. Nominees must be a member in good standing and have an active membership status for at least 12 continuous months at the time of election.
8. Nominees may not run for more than one position/office at any one time.
9. Nominations for any election shall close and be approved at the Board of Directors meeting immediately prior to the General Membership Meeting at which the election will occur.
10. The Nomination Committee chair is responsible for reporting the full slate of nominees and positions to the Secretary of the MRHS within two (2) days following the Board of Directors meeting.
11. Final nominations and sample ballots shall be presented in the MRHS Mainline Newsletter distributed prior to the election.
