



## **A policy of the Muskegon Railroad Historical Society Regulating Visitors and Guests**

**Enacted this September 19, 2006, the MRHS Board of Directors establishes the following policy regulating visitors and guests to the premises of the MRHS.**

In the effort to protect the health, safety, and well-being of all MRHS members, guests, visitors, and property held by the MRHS, the following rules are expected to be followed by and agreed to by visitors and guests of the MRHS. The MRHS encourages and invites anyone interested in railroads, both model and prototype, to visit our facilities with the following conditions:

1. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult or MRHS member. It can not be expected that members of the MRHS will supervise children.
2. All visitors and guests shall sign the visitor register.
3. Visitors and guests are expected to act in an appropriate manor and refrain from use of foul or inappropriate language.
4. Visitors and guests are not allowed to check out library materials
5. Visitors and guests are not allowed to operate the model layouts without the direct supervision of a MRHS member.
6. Visitors and guests shall be responsible for their actions, and any replacement or purchase of damaged property occurring as a result of their actions. If a visitor or guest damages an item, the replacement of the item will be charged to the visitor or guest.
